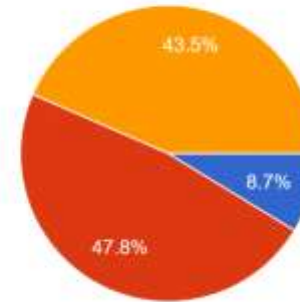

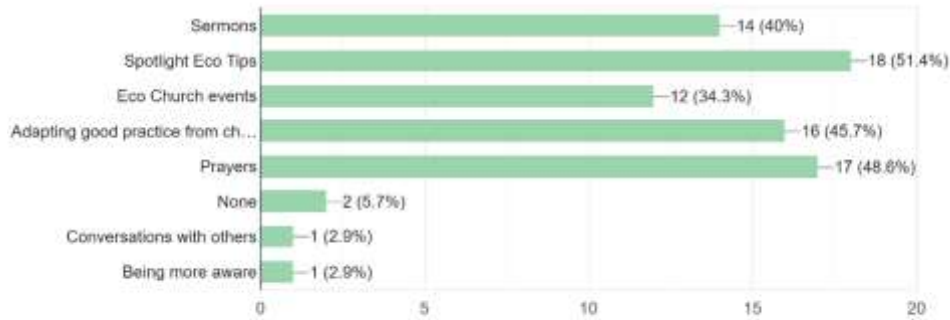

Which, if any, of the following Church activities have assisted and supported you in living a more environmentally friendly lifestyle (tick all that apply)

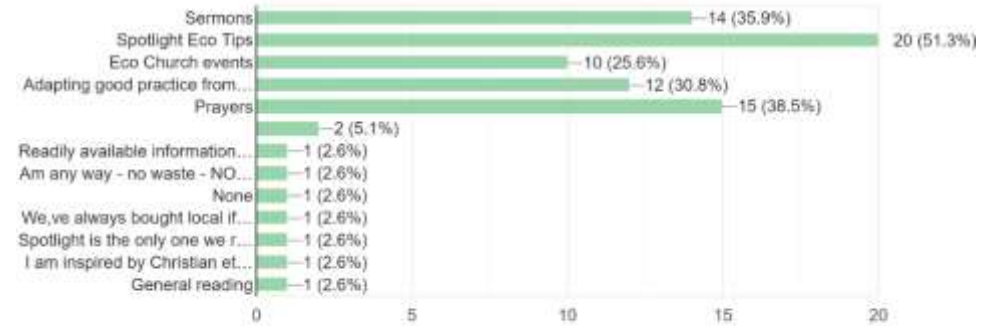
