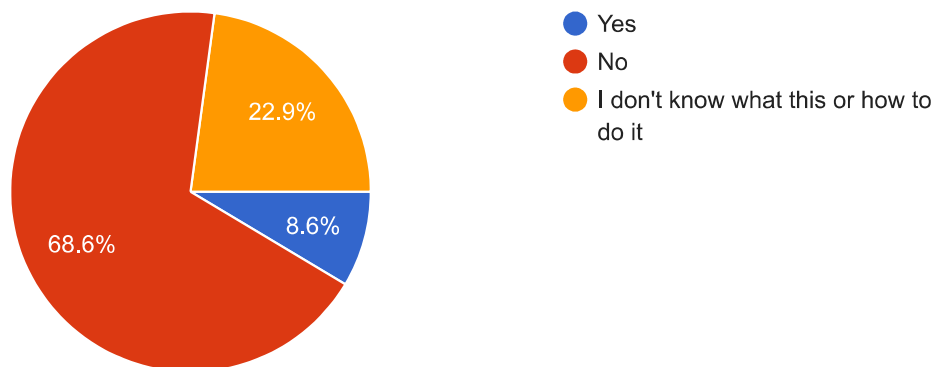


I have completed a personal carbon footprint audit in the last year.

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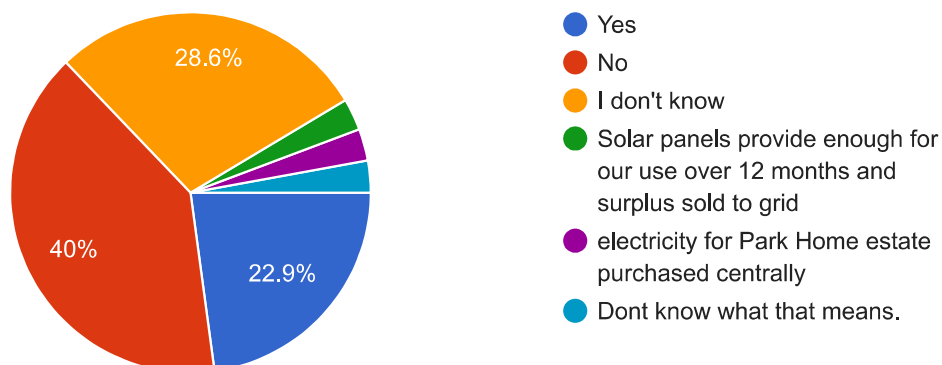

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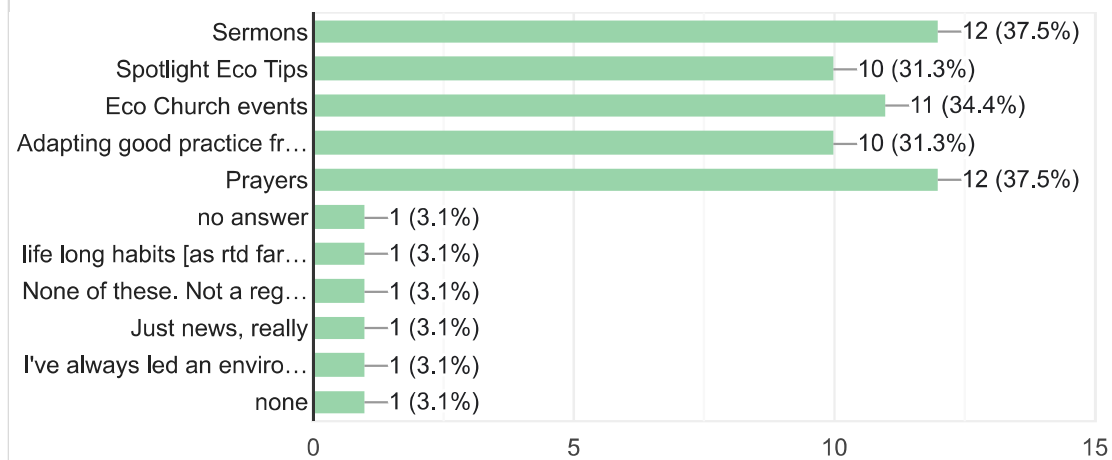
