A message from your Eco Church Team: Did you know that nearly 100 billion pieces of plastic packaging are thrown away by UK households every year, and just 12% is recycled in the UK. Please would you think about taking part in the nationwide "Big Plastic Count" survey. By counting all the plastic you throw away for a week, you can help gather the vital evidence that is needed to convince UK ministers, supermarkets and big brands to lead the way at global talks that could finally phase out plastic production for good. The count is taking place the week of 11-17th March.
